Scholarship Policy and Guidelines for the J.P. and Ethel Steadman Scholarship

The following documents should be postmarked by August 24, 2012

- A completed application form.
- A 3X5 photo of applicant. (Photo will remain property of scholarship committee).
- A 300-word essay concerning (double-spaced) "How the church has impacted applicant's life."
